- Tennis** : 10 courts including 2 indoor courts with floodlight capability (Hard Courts, Synthetic courts and Synthetic clay courts)
- Swimming** : 1 heated Indoor Pool (25-metre)
1 heated Outdoor Pool (23-metre)
3-level diving boards (1-metre, 3-metre, 5-metre)
1 Baby Pool
- Indoor sports** : 1 Bowling Alley with 4 lanes
1 Sports Hall (for badminton / basketball / volleyball / gymnastic)
2 Squash Courts
1 fully-equipped Fitness Centre
1 Golf Simulator
Sauna and Steam Rooms
- Junior activities** : Children playground
Kids Klub (aged 6 or below)
Soft Play Room (aged 6 or below)
The Hub (table games including foosball, air-hockey, table tennis, pool table and Play Station)
- Leisure** : Card Room for Bridge and Mahjong
Adult and Junior Libraries with over 5,000 books

Terms of Use by Reciprocal Members

- Letter of Introduction** : Required to confirm the Reciprocal Member's current active membership status with the Home Club and on non-HK residency status
- Registration** : Presentation of valid membership card of the Home Club and letter of introduction issued by the Home Club issued within 3 months from the visiting period.
- Maximum length of visit** : Thirty (30) days in one calendar year
- Daily visit fee** : HK\$185 (individual without children) / HK\$250 (family)
[Use of most of the recreational facilities are free of charge]
- Dress code** : Smart casual or sports etiquette whenever appropriate
- Guest policy** : Limit on number of guests allowed for using dining and sports facilities; suggest checking with Reception Desk upon arrival.
Daily fee HK\$130 per guest for using sports facilities
- Payment** : Debit card issued by the Reception Desk upon registration (value being topped up by cash or Visa/Master card with 3% surcharge)
